What is ASCP?

- ▶ The American Society of Consultant Pharmacists is the international professional association representing consultant and senior care pharmacists, providing leadership, education, advocacy, and resources to advance the practice of senior care pharmacy.
- ▶ **Vision**
 - ▶ The vision of the American Society of Consultant Pharmacists is optimal medication management and improved health outcomes for all older persons.
- ▶ **Mission**
 - ▶ The American Society of Consultant Pharmacists empowers pharmacists to enhance quality of care for all older persons through the appropriate use of medication and the promotion of healthy aging.



What is a Consultant Pharmacist?

- ▶ Knowledgeable and skilled in geriatric pharmacotherapy and the unique medication-related needs of seniors and long-term care residents
- ▶ Expert in long-term care settings for the frail at-risk elderly
- ▶ Patient-centered advocate for seniors at-risk for medication-related problems



What is a Consultant Pharmacist?

- ▶ **Settings**

 - ▶ Assisted living facilities (ALFs)
 - ▶ Hospice
 - ▶ Retail pharmacy
 - ▶ Subacute care facilities
 - ▶ Mental health facilities
 - ▶ Residential care/boarding homes
 - ▶ Hospitals
 - ▶ Correctional facilities
 - ▶ Home Health Agencies
 - ▶ Adult Day Care
 - ▶ Senior Centers
 - ▶ Area Agencies on Aging
 - ▶ Physicians' offices & group practice



What is a Consultant Pharmacist?

▶ Job Description

▶ **Consulting**

- Medication Regimen Review (MRR)
- Drug Utilization Review (DUR)
- Pharmacokinetic monitoring
- Review medication administration techniques
- Provide disease management and training programs
- Monitor for cost-effectiveness of medication therapy
- Counsel on Part D plan selection

▶ **Administrative responsibilities**

- Drug formulary management

▶ **Dispensing**



ASCP Fact Sheet

- ▶ Today there are 38 million seniors in the United States; by 2030, that number will rise to 75 million.
- ▶ Every day in the United States, another 6,000 people reach the age of 65.
- ▶ There are 5.5 million seniors with long-term disabilities in the United States. This figure is expected to increase to 10 million by the year 2020, and to 20 million by 2040.
- ▶ Adverse drug reactions are among the top five greatest threats to the health of seniors.
- ▶ 28% of hospitalizations among seniors are due to adverse drug reactions.

ASCP Fact Sheet

- ▶ 32,000 seniors suffer hip fractures each year due to falls caused by medication-related problems.
- ▶ The elderly account for 12.7% of the U.S. population, but consume approximately 34% of total prescriptions.
- ▶ On average, individuals 65 to 69 years old take nearly 14 prescriptions per year, individuals aged 80 to 84 take an average of 18 prescriptions per year.
- ▶ The number of seniors needing long-term care is projected to rise to 13.8 million by the year 2030; 5.3 million will reside in nursing homes and other long-term care facilities.
- ▶ There are more than 1.6 million nursing home beds in the United States; this represents an increase of over 25% since 1980.
